Qualification for all Masters Events is that the competitor must be over the age of 50 years on the 1st of September 2022 comply with the rules of the English Table Tennis Association the age for veterans is 40 years.

No participant may play in more than three events. In relation to Darts you must play in the Open events or Masters events and cannot mix. Police Sport UK Indoor Sports Committee has recommended that all Regional Qualifying Championships should take place by **31st December 2022**
